Club Rules

1. Entry Fee: Open Show - \$2.50 per bird. Junior Show - \$1.50 per bird.
2. This is an ABA and APA sanctioned show.
(unable to accept Turkeys, Geese or Guineas at this time)
3. **Entries must be postmarked no later than Friday October 21, 2011.** Please have your entries in on time. No telephone entries please. We will not be able to accept additional entries at the show. We are sorry, but we will be unable to issue any refunds requested after closing date.

5. **MARK YOUR ENTRIES:** Bantam or Standard - Bearded or Non-Bearded - Open Class or Junior Class.
6. Coops will be ready AT 4:00 P.M. on Friday, November 4th. **The building will close at 9:00 P.M. and re-open at 6:00A.M Saturday Morning.**
7. All entries **MUST** be cooped and ready for judging by 9:00 A.M. on Saturday morning.
8. Classifications:
 - Cocks & Hens - over 1 yr of age.
 - Cockerels and Pullets - under 1 yr of age
9. There will be a separate Junior Division for exhibitors between the ages of 5 and 16 years of age.

Those under the age of 5 and over the age of 16 will not be eligible for junior awards.
PLEASE MARK YOUR ENTRIES ACCORDINGLY.

JUNIOR ENTRIES ARE NOT TO BE ON THE SAME ENTRY FORM AS
OPEN ENTRIES.
A SEPARATE ENTRY SHEET IS REQUIRED FOR EACH JUNIOR ENTERING.

MUST BE PRESENT AT THE SHOW.**

10. BLOOD TESTING. Everyone will be required to comply with the Illinois blood testing requirements for this event. THIS WILL INCLUDE BOTH SHOW AND SALE BIRDS. Birds should be tested in advance since a tester will not be available at the Show. State of Illinois officials may be on hand to check test papers.

OUT OF STATE ENTRIES. All exhibitors entering Illinois with poultry for any reason except immediate slaughter are required to obtain an entry permit prior to entry. Permits are issued by calling 217-782-4944 and are issued 24 hours per day, seven days per week. ***It is up to the exhibitor to get their own permit number.***

11. FOR SALE COOPS. For sale coops will be available to exhibitors only at \$2.00 per coop. ONLY FOR SALE COOPS RESERVED AND PAID FOR IN ADVANCE WILL BE AVAILABLE. Limit of five coops per exhibitor. No coops may be brought in from the outside to display for sale birds.

****Selling from your vehicle in designated areas will be \$5.00**** See Joe Hoy

12. Feed and water will be provided - however, exhibitors will be required to tend their own birds.
13. **NO COOPING OUT UNTIL THE BIRDS ARE RELEASED BY SHOW OFFICIALS.**
14. Birds showing signs of sickness or disease **will be removed and barred from competition**, at the discretion of club directors.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CONTEST

A junior showmanship contest will be held for the junior exhibitors at this show. Please register with Don Davis by 10:30 A.M. on the morning of the show. The contest will begin at 11:00 A.M. There will be two age groups: Group 1 will be for the ages of 5 thru 9. Group 2 will be for the ages of 10 thru 16.

Rules are as follows:

- (1) There is no fee to enter the showmanship contest.
- (2) Please indicate on your entry form that you are entering the contest. Indicate your age on the entry form.
- (3) You do not need to be a member of a poultry club to enter. However, you must have entered and exhibited birds at this show.
- (4) Each exhibitor must bring one (1) bird of their choice (any breed – standard, bantam or bantam duck) to the ring. You, the exhibitor will be judged as follows: (1) the appearance/condition of your bird. (2) your knowledge of the bird, (3) how you handle the bird, and (4) your general enthusiasm.
- (5) Awards will be given in each group.

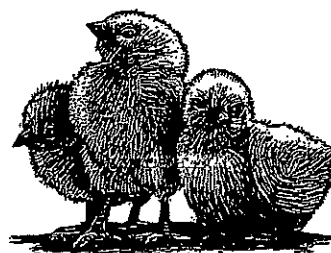
